> Meet with Architectural Control Committee (ACC) to submit:

- Approved Mason County Permits complete with one set of plans and specifications showing:
 - 1) The areas to be cleared and the trees and natural growth to be removed.
 - 2) The exact location of the construction on the lot.
 - 3) The size and dimensions of the structure.
 - 4) The locations of driveways and parking areas.
 - 5) The scheme for drainage and grading.
 - 6) The exterior design.
 - 7) The exterior color schemes with samples.
 - 8) Proposed basic landscaping plan.
- Clarify procedures and rules, questions.

> Site Visit Review with the ACC upon completion of these requirements:

• Trees and brush being removed marked with surveyor's tape and lot corners staked?

Receive approved Permit for tree removal and ground clearing, staked lot.

> <u>Site Visit to Review the following:</u>

- Construction footprint staked?
- Structure setbacks at 25' front, 5' sides and 20' back?
- Footprint situated appropriately to homes on either side?
- County setback from water's edge (if applicable)?
- Is any view by others compromised un-necessarily?
- Are there any height restrictions to consider?
