Treasurer's Report

LakeLand Village HOA Dues

LakeLand Village fiscal year runs April 1st through March 31st. The first HOA dues invoices were sent out at the beginning of March either by first- class mail or by email (if you have approved your first-class mail to be sent by email). HOA dues are due April 1st and will be considered late as of May 1st.

Property owners who have not paid their HOA Dues by May 1st will incur a late fee of \$15.00. Invoices with late fees will be sent via email and/or first-class mail at the beginning of May.

Fees Revised for New Fiscal Year 2023-2024

- Dues \$255.00 per year
- Dues late fees \$15.00 per month
- Boat Storage \$25.00 per year
- Property walkarounds \$25.00 per month after first month free.

LLVCC Patrol/Compliance

Believe it or not, Spring is upon us as evidenced by the colors that are starting to pop, as well as by the number of residents out and about. As you are driving through our village, please be aware of the speed limit (25 MPH) and the pedestrians enjoying the spring weather. Pedestrians, please stay to the side of the road and walk single file facing the traffic. Safety is a two-way street. Whether walking or driving, awareness is key.

LLVCC has covenants regarding leashing your pet. For the safety of your pet, please have your dog on a leash when out for walks. Please pick up after your pet; bags are provided throughout the village for your convenience.

Residents need to be aware of Division Covenants regarding trash burning, excessive noise, contractor hours, etc. Please refer to the Covenants for your Division.

All common areas within LLVCC close at dusk. Please be considerate of residents around the common areas and observe and follow the rules. Common areas are the swimming area, playground, basketball and tennis courts, boat launch, and the piers on the lake on Westlake North.

Year round, but especially during the summer months, LLVCC receives complaints about young people driving unlicensed, loud vehicles recklessly and at speeds over the posted limit (25 MPH) in the Village. If this behavior is observed, residents are encouraged to contact the Mason County Sheriff and report the incident.

Gazebo Reservations

If you are interested in reserving the gazebo for your party or event, fill out a reservation form (outside of the office or online), and turn it in to the office in person or by email. Reservations are first come, first served.

No Dogs in Tennis or Basketball Courts

Please do not allow your dogs to play on the tennis or basketball courts. Their urine and feces will adhere to the balls and transfer to players' hands. For health and safety reasons, please respect this request.
